Join the UK on 4th August for lights out at 10pm

At 11pm on 4th August 1914 Britain declared war on Germany, ushering in one of the darkest periods in our history.

As the moment approached, the British Foreign Secretary Sir Edward Grey made the famous remark:

"The lamps are going out all over Europe; we shall not see them lit again in our life-time"

In a dramatic UK-wide event **LIGHTS OUT** is an invitation to everyone to turn off their lights from 10-11pm on 4th August, leaving on a single light or candle for this shared moment of reflection.
