### Churches Together Foodbank

Food donations have been delivered to Yardley Wood foodbank and weighed 49.6 KG which is equivalent to 118 meals. All Food is welcome but Powdered Milk, Instant Mash Potato and Fruit Juices (or cordials) would be especially welcome.

The Foodbank in Yardley Wood is becoming increasingly self sufficient in that the donations are first used to make up food parcels locally; to the nationally agreed guidelines. Any excess is taken to Sparkhill. At one time Yardley Wood foodbank received most of their supplies from Sparkhill but that is now getting rarer.

On arrival the customer is offered a drink and a biscuit, asked about their overall needs, and, after receiving their food parcels are often signposted to other suitable agencies. Many thanks, Immanuel, for your continued support.

### 3D Course

We are holding a 3D course at Immanuel Church on Wednesday evenings starting in September. The 3D course is the Diocesan course for Developing Disciples. It is a thirty week course for those wishing to go deeper into an exploration of their Christian faith and calling.
