Coach trip to the Gloucestershire Warwickshire Steam Railway (GWSR) and Broadway

On Saturday 5th September we are planning a trip to the GWSR. The train runs from Toddington (not far from Broadway) through the Cotswold countryside to Cheltenham Racecourse.

The coach fare will be £10. At the main station at Toddington there are a variety of train fares to choose from and details of these are shown in the brochures available today or on the timetable on the notice board. We have deliberately not included a train ticket so as to give everyone a choice of how to spend time at the Railway. At Toddington there is a cafe and a shop on the platform. There is also a garden centre next to the station. At Winchcombe - the next station there is a tea room together with a newly sited Discovery coach giving a history of the Railway. Picnic areas are at both stations.

We hope to leave Immanuel around 9.30am, arriving at Toddington around 10.45am. We plan to leave Toddington mid-afternoon to travel the short distance to Broadway where we can spend time prior to returning home.
